

Bill Pell. Bill Pell graduated from Saint Peter High School in 1957. Bill's contributions to the life and vitality of the community of Saint Peter cannot be overstated. Bill established Pell Insurance and Real Estate in 1963 and was the long-time chairman of the board for First National Bank. He had significant influence in attracting numerous businesses, industries, and community assets to Saint Peter, including Alumacraft Boat Company, Dollars for Scholars, and the Saint Peter Hospital (now River's Edge Hospital and Clinic). He was a member of the Saint Peter Area Chamber of Commerce and the Saint Peter Ambassadors. Bill's passion for baseball extended far beyond his playing days at Saint Peter High School. He was instrumental in the establishment of Babe Ruth baseball in Saint Peter and was a member of the Saint Peter amateur baseball organization for many years. He was also an avid Minnesota Twins and Chicago Cubs fan. Bill died in 2008; however, his legacy continues to be felt throughout the Saint Peter community.
