### Have you ever heard of a FREE LUNCH?

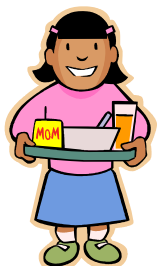
St. Peter School District is sponsoring FREE LUNCHES and READING ACTIVITIES for children this summer!!!!

- What:** Free Lunch for all children who attend. There are no income guidelines required. Adults may choose to purchase a lunch for \$3.25.
- Activities:** All children are invited to participate in FREE reading activities scheduled during the program. Activities include: story time, books to read, open library for 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade students and more! (Reading activities are not required)
