

ROSEMARY MICKELSON -- Rosemary Mickelson, who passed away on June 5, 2014, was a long-time English teacher at St. Peter High School (1964 to 1990). A native of Albion, Neb., Rosemary earned her undergraduate teaching degree from Nebraska State College of Wayne and also did graduate school work at Chadron State (Neb.), the University of Northern Colorado-Greeley, the University of Minnesota and Mankato State University.
